PUBLIC TRANSPORT

BUS

The map overleaf shows the location of bus stops around City South Campus; a number of fast and frequent services stop on Westbourne Road and Harborne Road, including routes **10, 23, 24 and 25**.

TRAIN & METRO

Five Ways train station is around a 15-minute walk from the Campus, or just over five minutes by bike.

The nearest Metro station is Corporation Street, which is around 25 minutes walk from City South Campus. Services run frequently between the city centre and Wolverhampton, via West Bromwich, Wednesbury & Bilston.

Work is underway to extend the tramway further from Library Metro stop along Broad Street to Hagley Road in Edgbaston (just west of Five Ways). This is due to open in 2021.

If you regularly travel by train, Metro or bus (or a combination of these), make sure you get the best value ticket: networkwestmidlands.com/swift/swift-ticket-finder/

ACTIVE TRAVEL

Over 40 cycle parking spaces are provided at the City South Campus. Inside the Seacole Building, showers and changing rooms are provided, along with lockers for storing equipment including a small number of Brompton lockers.

Save on the cost of a bike, pick up a second-hand bike at Birmingham Bike Foundry, or check which local bike shops offer student discount.

Hire a Bike from one of the Brompton Docks around the city centre or contact us to borrow a bike for up to 12 weeks for free, visit bcu.ac.uk/green-travel for more information.

If you do need to travel by car, see if you could share your journey; register for free and search for a match at: liftshare.com/uk

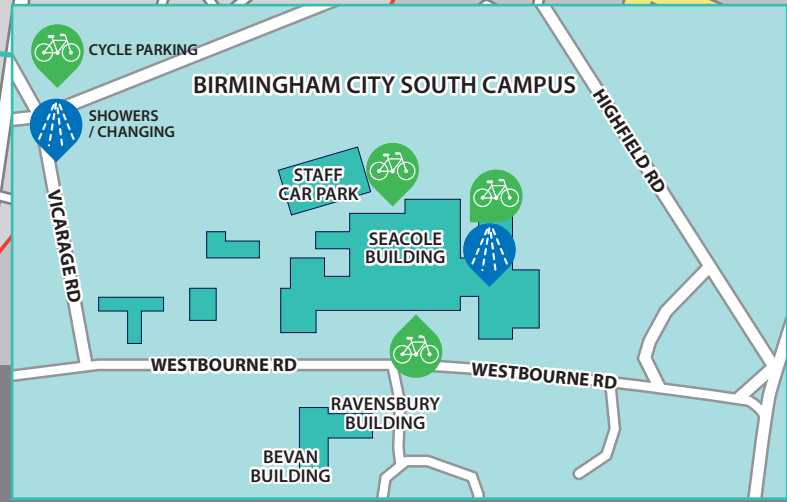
