Factsheet 1: Advocacy Strategies for CSOs

(1) Creating CSO Networks

CSOs can create 'coalitions' comprised of multiple CSOs that collectively and strategically participate in the UPR.

(2) Using Visuals

Alongside stakeholder reports, CSOs can create shorter, more visually attractive documents to inform Member State recommendations.

(3) Lobbying Member States

CSOs are encouraged to take part in targeted lobbying of Member States, both in Geneva and online.

(4) Engaging with the Review

CSOs can engage with the review through live streaming the UN Web TV link and using social media to promote key points.

(5) Supporting Implementation

CSOs should take a clear and strategic approach to supporting the domestic implementation of UPR recommendations.

(6) Reporting on Implementation

CSOs can submit mid-term reports to the UN, providing progress updates on implementation.
