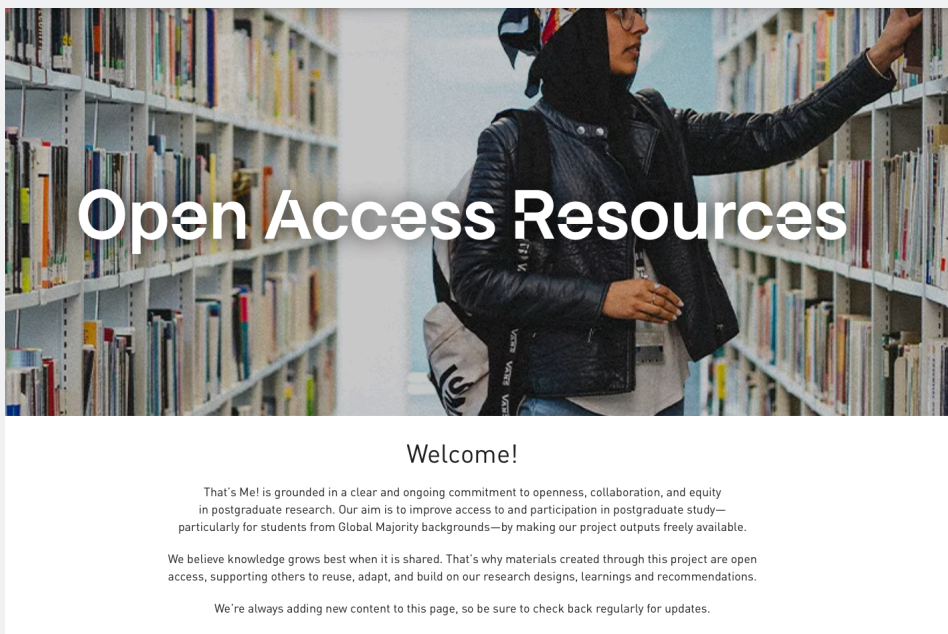


Figure 1 (Birmingham City University's Open Access Resources Landing Page)
