SPC Terms of Reference

The purpose of the BCU ITE Strategic Secondary and Primary Partnership Committees are to ensure that the future direction of all BCU ITE Programmes are driven by a focus on school-led issues and a drive to impact on pupil outcomes in all regional schools. The committee ensures that the needs of the Partnership stakeholders are at the forefront of the all ITE Programmes' visions for continuous improvement.

Each Committee is jointly chaired by BCU ITE Programme Leads and experienced senior leaders from Lead or Principal BCU Partnership Schools. Together they ensure that the future workforce requirements of the region's schools are anticipated, gathered, collated and, implemented, as priority actions for BCU ITE Programmes.

Each Committee has a direct impact on the BCU ITE Departments' Improvement Plans, and through this, the Self Evaluation Document (SED). Through the Committees, BCU ITE Programmes consider the policy landscape and the demographic needs of the region and respond to these in a way that will ensure "profession ready" ECTs at the end of each QTS programme.

Committees fulfil their strategic role by:

- Directly challenging the BCU course team on the Improvement Plan and the SED.
- Gathering Professional and Subject Mentor feedback on placements and the course, and considering trainee feedback from evaluations.
- Addressing requirements within the ITT Core Content Framework

- Providing an essential bridge between HE research and school practice – leading to evidence based research and evidence based practice.
